Thomas Commends Mayor Fenty, MPD for Solving Recent Ward 5 Homicides

Washington, DC—Councilmember Harry “Tommy” Thomas, Jr. praised Mayor Adrian Fenty and the Metropolitan Police Department today for the arrest of suspects in two of Ward 5’s open homicide cases: the triple homicide that occurred on the 1100 block of Holbrook Street, NE on May 31, 2008, and claimed the lives of Duane Hough, Anthony Mincey, and Johnny Jeter; and the death of 12-year-old Marisol Caceres on July 29, 2008, which occurred at 60 Hawaii Avenue, NE.

“I commend Mayor Fenty, Chief Lanier, Assistant Chief Groomes, 5D Commander Greene, 4D Commander Brown, and the detectives assigned to these cases for their solving these horrendous crimes,” said Councilmember Thomas. “I am extremely grateful and pleased that MPD was able to apprehend and arrest individuals involved in these tragic deaths. This is an example of excellent police work,” stated Thomas.
